Surgery Health Pod



You may have noticed a new piece of equipment in the waiting area recently. This is our health pod. You can use the pod to perform your own tests without the supervision of a Doctor or Nurse. The results of the tests are sent directly to your medical record and will be available to your Doctor whenever you see them. The Pod can do the following:

- Blood Pressure Checks
- Height and Weight
- Body Mass Index
- Asthma Checks
- Epilepsy Checks
- Contraceptive Checks

If you have High Blood Pressure

Use the pod to check your blood pressure when you order your repeat medication and you may save yourself an appointment with the nurse or doctor

Minor Ailments
Scheme You can
get advice and treatment
for a range of conditions
from your local pharmacist
instead of visiting your
GP practice.

This means that you do not have to wait for an appointment. When you join the scheme we will give you a minor ailments patient passport. When you take the passport to the pharmacy, the pharmacist will assess you and give advice and treatment as appropriate.

Any medicines dispensed will be **free of charge** if you

do not normally pay prescription charges. If you normally pay for your prescriptions you will be charged the retail price of the medication or the prescription charge.....whichever is the cheaper.
